MURRAY JOINS LEE COUNTY PORT AUTHORITY AS SENIOR MANAGER OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

FORT MYERS, Fla. (Feb. 27, 2008) – Phillip Murray has been named senior manager of information technology for the Lee County Port Authority. He is responsible for the operation and improvement of the airport's telecommunications services, computer systems and networking, as well as providing oversight and guidance to information technology staff at Southwest Florida International Airport and Page Field General Aviation Airport.

Prior to joining the Lee County Port Authority, Murray served 11 years at McCarran International Airport in Las Vegas, where he was the technical services manager for the Clark County Department of Aviation.
