AIR SERVICE NEWS

Air Berlin (AB)

- Air Berlin operates four weekly nonstop flights to Düsseldorf (DUS). Air Berlin's partner airlines offer convenient connecting flights to points throughout Europe, Africa and Asia from DUS.

Air Canada (AC)

- Air Canada offers weekly service to Toronto, Canada (YYZ) during the summer months and will increase this to daily service starting in November. They will also be bringing back the weekly service to Montreal (YMQ), starting in December.

AirTran Airways (FL)

- AirTran Airways inaugurated weekly nonstop service to Grand Rapids, Michigan (GRR) on June 12. This is the first-ever scheduled nonstop service to GRR from RSW. AirTran offers service to 13 nonstop destinations - more than any other carrier at RSW.

Frontier Airlines (F9)

- Frontier operates three weekly nonstop flights to Denver, Colorado (DEN) during the summer months and will increase frequency starting in November. Frontier offers convenient connecting flights to the West Coast and points throughout Mexico from its hub in DEN.

Southwest Airlines (WN)

- Southwest will add a third daily nonstop flight to Chicago-Midway (MDW) starting November 1.

WestJet (WS)

- WestJet offers three weekly nonstop flights to Toronto, Canada (YYZ) during the summer months, increasing to daily service starting in November.
