**RSW PROVIDES NONSTOP SERVICE TO 44 DESTINATIONS (41 DOMESTIC & 3 INTERNATIONAL).
THIS SERVICE IS PROVIDED BY 20 DIFFERENT AIR CARRIERS AT RSW.**

AIR SERVICE NEWS

Air Berlin (AB)

- Air Berlin announced they will be joining the Oneworld airline alliance. This will allow Air Berlin passengers to have seamless connecting flights and earn frequent flier miles on other Oneworld alliance carriers (American Airlines, British Airways, Finnair, Qantas, LAN, Iberia, JAL, Cathay Pacific, Royal Jordanian and Malev). Air Berlin operates four weekly nonstop flights to Düsseldorf (DUS) and their partner airlines offer convenient connecting flights to points throughout Europe, Africa and Asia from DUS.

Air Canada (AC)

- This coming winter and spring season, Air Canada will offer two daily flights to Toronto, Canada (YYZ). Air Canada will also be bringing back weekly nonstop service to Montreal (YUL), starting in December.

AirTran Airways (FL) **NEW!**

- AirTran Airways will inaugurate weekly nonstop service to **Rochester (ROC) on November 20 and Moline/Quad Cities (MLI) in the first quarter of 2011 (start date forthcoming)**. This will be the first-ever nonstop service to both Moline/Quad Cities and Rochester from Fort Myers. Recently, AirTran inaugurated nonstop service to Grand Rapids, Michigan (GRR). In addition AirTran will add a second daily flight to Columbus (CMH) on November 4. With the addition of ROC and MLI, AirTran will offer service to 15 nonstop destinations, more than any carrier at RSW.

Frontier Airlines (F9)

- Frontier operates three weekly nonstop flights to Denver, Colorado (DEN) during the summer months and will increase frequency starting in November. Frontier offers convenient connecting flights to the West Coast and points throughout Mexico from its hub in DEN.

Southwest Airlines (WN) **NEW!**

- Southwest Airlines will inaugurate weekly nonstop service to Nashville, TN (BNA) on January 15, 2011 the service will be upgraded to daily service on February 13. Southwest will also be adding additional service to Chicago-Midway (MDW) and Baltimore-Washington (BWI) this season.

Sun Country (SY) **NEW!**

- Sun Country will inaugurate weekly nonstop service to **Lansing, Michigan (LAN) starting on December 23**. This will be the first time RSW will have nonstop service between Fort Myers and Lansing. In addition, Sun Country offers daily nonstop service to Minneapolis (MSP) from September through June.

WestJet (WS)

- Westjet offers three weekly nonstop flights to Toronto, Canada (YYZ) during the summer months, and will increase this to daily starting in November.
