



**Breeze Airways Inaugurating 8 Routes from Fort Myers This Week:  
Seasonal Service to Portland and Richmond Starts Today,  
Akron/Canton, Columbus and Louisville Start Thursday,  
Pittsburgh, Raleigh-Durham and Syracuse Start on Friday  
-- Fares Starting From \$29\* One Way --**

**Fort Myers, FL (November 15, 2023)** – [Breeze Airways](#), the U.S.' only NLCC, or 'Nice Low Cost Carrier,' inaugurates eight new seasonal routes this week from Fort Myers with service to Portland, ME, and Richmond, VA starting today. Flights to Akron/Canton, OH; Columbus, OH; and Louisville, KY start on Thursday, while service to Pittsburgh, PA; Raleigh-Durham, NC; and Syracuse, NY starts on Friday.

Fares on the new nonstop flights start from \$29\* one-way, if purchased by November 21, 2023 for travel between January 8 and February 7, 2024.

Breeze also started service from Fort Myers to New Orleans, LA; and Norfolk, VA on November 2. With existing service to Charleston, SC; Hartford, CT; Las Vegas, NV; and Providence, RI, Breeze currently serves 14 destinations from Fort Myers.

- Akron-Canton, OH\*\* (Winter/Spring seasonal, Tues, Thurs, and Sun, starting Nov 16, Nice from \$29\* one way);
- Columbus, OH\*\* (Winter/Spring seasonal, Tues, Thurs, and Sun, starting Nov 16, Nice from \$39\*);
- Louisville, KY\*\* (Winter/Spring seasonal, Thurs and Sun, starting Nov 16, Nice from \$45\*);
- Pittsburgh, PA\*\* (Winter/Spring seasonal, Mon, Wed, Fri, and Sat, starting Nov 17, Nice from \$49\*);
- Raleigh-Durham, NC\*\* (Winter/Spring seasonal, Mon and Fri, starting Nov 17, Nice from \$29\*); and
- Syracuse, NY\*\* (Winter/Spring seasonal, Mon and Fri, starting Nov 17, Nice from \$59\*).

“We are excited that Breeze is adding eight new nonstop destinations this week at Southwest Florida International Airport, bringing their total number of nonstop markets to 14 at RSW,” said Ben Siegel, CPA, C.M., executive director of the Lee County Port Authority. “Starting today, we are pleased to welcome Breeze passengers from two markets not currently being served at RSW - Richmond, Virginia (RIC) and Portland, Maine (PWM). They will also be starting nonstop service between RSW and six other cities throughout the week giving visitors to Southwest Florida many more options for travel this winter.”
